Media registration is limited to reporters and editors of the general, medical and scientific media. Media registration will not be extended to advertising personnel. Media credentials may be required.

## **ORS Annual Meeting Embargo Policy**

---

Media are required to abide by the embargo policies governing the Annual Meeting of the ORS. The embargo policy states that coverage of abstracts being presented at the Annual Meeting is strictly prohibited until the start time of the presentation or the beginning of the media briefing containing the research, whichever comes first. The embargo on poster presentations lifts when the poster session containing the poster opens for viewing. Content that may be pre-published online in advance of print publication is still subject to the ORS embargo policy.

## **On-Site Guidelines**

---

Registered media are required to wear the ORS media badges at all times while on site at the Annual Meeting. All scientific sessions, education sessions, oral and poster abstract sessions, and special events at the Annual Meeting are open to the media. Entry into sessions requires a badge. Registered media (with badges) are the only attendees permitted to photograph and audiotape sessions (except for those who have obtained written permission from the ORS beforehand). Videotaping any of the ORS sessions/events is strictly prohibited. If the media are interested in videotaping onsite, they can do so only with the permission of the ORS and when accompanied by an ORS media relations staff member.

Media is welcome to use the ORS staff office equipped with PCs/Internet access and printers. Special requests related to media facilities above and beyond what is typically provided by the ORS must be made in writing no less than 2 months prior to the annual meeting, and must be approved by the ORS.
