The call for abstracts for the ORS 2025 Annual Meeting is now closed. We received 2,176 submissions. Those are currently under review and we will notify those who have been accepted on November 6. If you missed your opportunity to submit, the call for late-breaking abstracts will be open October 14 - November 11.

Opportunities for Awards and Grants



Applications and nominations are now being accepted for the following awards:

ORS/OREF Distinguished Investigator Award: Honors an individual with a long-standing, productive career in orthopaedic research. (***Nominations Due September 16.***)

ORS Early Career Outreach Travel Award: 10 awards of \$300 each will go to volunteers who will participate in ORS's Open Door event at the ORS 2025 Annual Meeting. (***Submissions Due September 16.***)

Outstanding Achievement in Mentoring Award: Recognition of an outstanding mentor in the ORS community who promotes the success of new investigators in the pursuit of independent orthopaedic research. (***Nominations Due September 19.***)

Marshall R. Urist, MD Award: \$5,000 to honor an investigator who has a sustained ongoing body of focused research in tissue regeneration as it relates to the musculoskeletal system. (***Nominations Due September 19.***)

Spine Section Travel Fellowship: \$1,500 for an ORS Spine Section researcher at any career level to collaborate with an established and committed host Principal Investigator. (***The Deadline for Submissions Extended to September 30.***)

Dr. Peter Roughly Award: \$2,000 for exchange travel to a mentor and trainee team researching spine, disc, and cartilage biology. (***The Deadline for Submissions Extended to September 30.***)

Fred Nelson Scientific Communication Award: Recognition of an ORS member with a proven record of scientific communication over the last three years. (***Nominations Due October 1.***)

Underrepresented in STEM Minority Undergraduate Travel Award Program: Complimentary registration for up to two undergraduate students from participating institutions to attend the ORS 2025 Annual Meeting. Candidates for this award must identify as a member of at least one underrepresented group in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math (STEM). (***Nominations Due October 4.***)

ORS/PSRS Diversity Travel Fellowship Award: Provides complimentary registration, expenses, and mentoring to researchers from underrepresented communities to attend the 7th International Spine Research Symposium for the first time. (***Submissions Due October 7.***)

Spine Section Diversity Stipend Awards: \$500 awards given to provide financial assistance and personal mentoring to help underrepresented spine research trainees to attend the ORS 2025 Annual Meeting. (***Submissions Due November 29.***)

William H. Harris, MD Award: \$5,000 honorarium awarded to an individual based on the quality and scientific merit of basic or clinical research on the hip published in the previous year in the *Journal of Orthopaedic Research (JOR)*. (***Authors Can Indicate Interest in Applying at the Time of Manuscript Submission to the Journal.***)
