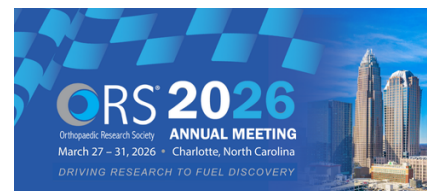

Policy Fellow Opportunity

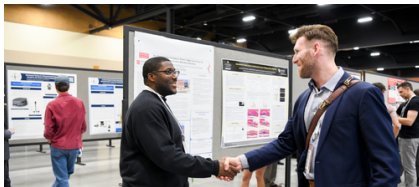
